Pastor E.A. Adeboye's Sermon at RCCG Communion Service

Here is the excerpt from the sermon:

Bible text: Ezekiel 37

- When God asked Ezekiel if the bones could live again, he replied that only God knew because the bones were dry.
- God asked him to speak to the bones; he obeyed, and the bones came together, and flesh covered them.
- God asked him to speak again, and the wind blew, and the bones became a mighty army. I hereby decree that your dry bones shall live again.
- I decree that where your situation appears to be totally hopeless, you will get a surprise.
- I decree; Where there has been no way in your life, there will be a way.
- I decree, before the end of this month, God will bring water out of the rock for you. Isaiah 35: 10
- In the Name of the One Who made heaven and earth, you will return next month; you will return with songs. There will be everlasting joy upon your head.
- There is something called the oil of gladness. Psalm 23:5
- I decree in the Name above every other name, your joy will overflow.

Read Exekiel 37:10

The hand of the Lord was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the Lord, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones,

² And caused me to pass by them round about: and, behold, there were very many in the open valley;

and, lo, they were very dry.

³ And he said unto me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, O Lord God, thou knowest.

⁴ Again he said unto me, Prophecy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the Lord.

⁵ Thus saith the Lord God unto these bones; Behold, I will cause breath to enter into you, and ye shall live:

⁶ And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and ye shall live; and ye shall know that I am the Lord.

⁷ So I prophesied as I was commanded: and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and behold a shaking, and the bones came together, bone to his bone.

⁸ And when I beheld, lo, the sinews and the flesh came up upon them, and the skin covered them above: but there was no breath in them.

⁹ Then said he unto me, Prophecy unto the wind, prophecy, son of man, and say to the wind, Thus saith the Lord God; Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe upon these slain, that they may live.

¹⁰ So I prophesied as he commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they lived, and stood up upon their feet, an exceeding great army.
