Then he said, I have sinned: yet honour me now, I pray thee, before the elders of my people, and before Israel, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD thy God.

BIBLE TEXT: 1 Samuel 15:24-30

²⁴ And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the Lord, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.

²⁶ And Samuel said unto Saul, I will not return with thee: for thou hast rejected the word of the Lord, and the Lord hath rejected thee from being king over Israel.

²⁵ Now therefore, I pray thee, pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the Lord.

Fame is something that many people pursue without actually knowing just how dangerous it is. Once you are in the limelight, you have to become extra careful.

You have to watch your every move because people are looking at you. Sometimes when we go for an event and I am to sit at the high table, my driver will say "You sit at the high table and we will sit where we can eat".

Those at the high table, though hungry, always act otherwise. Even if they eat at all, it would only be a little, with plenty of caution because all eyes are on them.

When you are famous, it is as if you are on the high table everyday of your life and believe me honestly, there is nothing like just being free to do whatever you want to do without anyone looking at you.

When you are famous, you cannot even take a stroll outside or play in a public place like every other person.

One of the dangers of being famous is that people tend to forget that famous people are human beings too.

I thank God that I have never been after fame so I show regularly that I am as human as anybody can be. I still occasionally buy roasted plantain on the roadside.
