OPEN HEAVEN 15 AUGUST 2025 TODAY DEVOTIONAL

TOPIC: ALWAYS REFILL V

MEMORISE:

O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth. Psalms 96:9

READ: John 4:23-24

23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

RCCG OPEN HEAVEN 15 AUGUST 2025 TODAY MESSAGE

Yesterday, I started a discussion about how important it is for you to recharge your spiritual battery by

studying, memorising, and meditating on the word of God. Today, I'll discuss worship as another way you can recharge your spiritual battery.

Many people allow the choir to do the worshipping for them in church during services. I thank God for all the spirit-filled choristers around the world who lead powerful praise and worship sessions, but they cannot worship God on your behalf. You must learn to worship God yourself.

In Ephesians 5:18-19, Apostle Paul says:

And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;

The above Scripture implies that you should sing very often, even in your conversations with other people. Paul specifically says that you should sing hymns because they are inspired by the Holy Spirit. I thank God for the songs and choruses that we have today, but most of them fade with time. Many hymns, however, have stood the test of time; a lot of them were written hundreds of years ago, but they remain evergreen.

In today's Bible reading, Jesus said that God is a Spirit, and those who worship Him must do so in spirit and in truth because the Father seeks such people to worship Him. When you are a worshipper, the Holy Spirit will seek you out.

Worship means reverencing someone or something. When you worship God, you revere Him; you place Him in the highest position in your life. Everyone on earth is a worshipper; people worship one thing or the other. The way to know what a fellow worships is to check what he or she holds in high esteem. For instance, when people cannot do without checking their phones or scrolling through them, such phones have become objects of worship. When someone can do anything for money, that fellow is worshipping money.

Worship also means submission. You submit to whomever or whatever you worship. When you worship God, you are submitting and surrendering your heart to Him so that He can fill it with His power and glory. When you submit to God, He comes and dwells in you.

Beloved, make singing praises to God and worshipping Him your lifestyle. When you engage in these spiritual acts constantly, He will fill you with His Spirit and keep your spiritual battery charged at all times.

OPEN HEAVEN 15 AUGUST PRAYER POINT

Spend some time worshipping God for His greatness, faithfulness, and mercy every day.

Jeremiah 37-39

OPEN HEAVEN DEVOTIONAL 15 AUGUST 2025 COMMENTARY

MEMORISE: Psalms 96:9

"O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before Him, all the earth."

This verse reveals **true worship** as both **adoration** (beauty) and **reverence** (fear)—a divine encounter that transforms the worshiper.

BIBLE READING: John 4:23-24

Jesus' words define authentic worship:

- 1. v.23: Spirit-empowered ("in spirit")
- 2. v.24: Truth-anchored ("in truth")
- 3. Divine Priority: The Father actively seeks such worshipers

Worship as Spiritual Recharge

Daddy Adeboye's teaching unveils four dimensions of worship as a refilling conduit:

1. Personal Worship vs. Delegated Praise

Choir's Role

Your Responsibility

Leads corporate worship Must engage personally (Psalm 34:1)

Ministers through music Your life as continuous worship (Romans 12:1)

Can inspire Cannot substitute your devotion

Key Example:

• David danced personally before the Ark (2 Samuel 6:14)—no proxy worship

2. The Hymn Advantage (Ephesians 5:19)

- Why Hymns?
 - Theological depth: "A Mighty Fortress" declares God's sovereignty
 - o Generational legacy: Connect to centuries of saints
 - o Spiritual warfare: Many hymns were birthed in crises (e.g., "It Is Well" after Horatio

Spafford's tragedy)

3. Worship as Submission

- Modern Idolatry Test:
 - Phone addiction = Digital worship
 - Workaholism = Career worship
- True Worship:
 - Surrenders control (James 4:7)
 - Invades daily routines (e.g., singing while cooking, driving)

How to Cultivate a Worship Lifestyle

1. The 3-S Worship Model

- 1. Scheduled:
 - 15 mins morning worship (Psalm 59:16)
 - 5 mins "commute praise" (car/bus worship)
- 2. Spontaneous:
 - Whisper hymns during work breaks
- 3. Sacrificial:
 - Worship especially when feeling low (Habakkuk 3:17-18)

2. Create a "Warfare Worship" Playlist

- 5 hymns for spiritual battles (e.g., "Rock of Ages," "Holy Holy Holy")
- Play during:
 - Temptation attacks
 - Anxiety moments

3. Practice "Eyes-Open Worship"

- Worship while working: Sing silently in your heart (Colossians 3:23)
- Transform chores into altars (e.g., mopping = "Wash me, Lord")

Prayer for a Worshiper's Heart

*"Father, break my worship lethargy! Make me a **24/7 worshiper**—not just in church aisles but in traffic jams, office cubicles, and kitchen sinks. Let my life become a **perpetual love song** to You, in Jesus' name!"*

Action Steps

- 1. **Hymn Memorization**: Learn 1 stanza weekly (start with "Be Thou My Vision")
- 2. Worship Journal: Record divine encounters during praise sessions
- 3. Idolatry Audit: List 3 things competing with God for worship—fast from 1 this week

Conclusion: The Worshiper's Reward

Daddy Adeboye's life demonstrates: Those God seeks (John 4:23) become vessels He fills.

"Your worship isn't about perfect pitch—it's about postured surrender. When you empty yourself in praise, God fills you with power."
