OPEN HEAVEN 25 JUNE 2025 TODAY DEVOTIONAL

TOPIC: FEAR GOD ALONE II

MEMORISE:

Say ye not, A confederacy, to all them to whom this people shall say, A confederacy; neither fear ye their fear, nor be afraid.

Sanctify the LORD of hosts himself; and let him be your fear, and let him be your dread. Isaiah 8:12-13

READ: Psalms 112:1-10

- 1 Praise ye the Lord. Blessed is the man that feareth the Lord, that delighteth greatly in his commandments.
- 2 His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.
- 3 Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever.
- 4 Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: he is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.

- 5 A good man sheweth favour, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion.
- 6 Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance.
- 7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the Lord.
- 8 His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies.
- 9 He hath dispersed, he hath given to the poor; his righteousness endureth for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honour.
- 10 The wicked shall see it, and be grieved; he shall gnash with his teeth, and melt away: the desire of the wicked shall perish.

RCCG OPEN HEAVEN 25 JUNE 2025 TODAY MESSAGE

Some people are afraid of witches, wizards, and other forces of darkness. Some other people are afraid of their bosses, some are afraid of failure, and some are even afraid of success. There are even some people who are afraid of their own shadows! I know that many people, situations, or even objects can indeed seem fearsome; however, you must understand that 2 Timothy 1:7 says: For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

God is the only being in the entire universe that is worth fearing. Jesus said in Matthew 10:28: And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

When you are afraid of people, situations, or anything at that, you are not walking in the fullness of the freedom Jesus paid for you to have. If you are still afraid of some things, it means that you have not yet understood that Jesus has made you free indeed (John 8:36). It doesn't matter how wealthy, intelligent, famous, or influential you are; if you are afraid, you are living in constant torment and are in bondage (1 John 4:18).

When Jesus sets anyone free, He gives the fellow all things that pertain to life and godliness; everything the fellow needs to establish his or her freedom (2 Peter 1:3). Jesus came to deliver us from the fear of death (Hebrews 2:14-15). The moment a fellow comes to Jesus Christ, he or she does not have to be afraid of death anymore.

The Bible says in Psalm 112:1: "Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments."

This Scripture clearly states that the people who fear God are blessedindeed. A fellow who fears God indeed will delight greatly in His commandments. You can't claim to fear God and despise, disrespect, or disobey His instructions. When you fear God, you love His laws and obey them.

Beloved, there is no need to be afraid of anyone or anything; God is the only one you should fear. Trust in Him, and He will deliver you from all forms of fear. Put all your focus on God, delight in His word, obey His commandments, and He will keep you in perfect peace all the days of your life (Isaiah 26:3).

The Divine Antidote to All Fears

The Many Faces of Fear

The devotional identifies several common fears that plague humanity:

- 1. **Spiritual fears** Witches, wizards, dark forces
- 2. **Social fears** Bosses, authorities, people's opinions
- 3. Psychological fears Failure, success, even one's shadow

These fears reveal our fundamental misunderstanding of true spiritual authority and our position in Christ.

The Biblical Perspective on Fear

- 1. What Fear Is Not (2 Timothy 1:7)
 - Not from God
 - Not part of our redeemed nature
 - Not compatible with our identity in Christ
- 2. What Fear Should Be
 - Reserved exclusively for God (Matthew 10:28)
 - Awe-inspired reverence (Proverbs 9:10)
 - Loving obedience (John 14:15)

The Power of Godly Fear

Characteristics of Those Who Fear God (Psalm 112)

- 1. They Are Blessed (v.1)
 - o Divine favor rests upon them
 - Enjoy supernatural provision
- 2. They Are Established (v.2-3)
 - Generational blessings
 - Financial stability
 - Lasting legacy
- 3. They Are Fearless (v.4,7-8)
 - Light in darkness
 - Steadfast in trouble
 - Confident in ultimate victory

The Freedom of Fearing God Alone

- 1. **Deliverance from Death's Fear** (Hebrews 2:14-15)
 - Christ destroyed death's power
 - Eternal perspective changes everything
- 2. Liberation from Human Opinion (Galatians 1:10)
 - When God is our audience, people's views fade
 - o Boldness in witness and service
- 3. Victory Over Spiritual Oppression (1 John 4:4)
 - o Greater is He that is in us
 - No demonic force can withstand God's presence

Practical Steps to Overcoming Fear

Spiritual Disciplines for Fearless Living

- 1. **Daily Word Immersion** (Joshua 1:8)
 - Scripture memorization
 - Meditation on God's promises
- 2. Consistent Prayer Life (Philippians 4:6-7)
 - Petition with thanksgiving
 - Spiritual warfare prayers
- 3. Obedience in Small Things (Luke 16:10)
 - o Faithfulness builds spiritual muscle
 - Prepares for greater challenges

Mind Renewal Strategies

- 1. Identify Fear Sources
 - Trace roots of specific fears

- Renounce generational fear patterns
- 2. Replace Lies with Truth
 - o Combat fearful thoughts with Scripture
 - "I will not fear" declarations (Psalm 118:6)
- 3. Practice Fear Exposure
 - o Gradual facing of fears with faith
 - o Spiritual "immunization" through small victories

The Blessings of Fearless Living

Personal Benefits

- 1. Perfect Peace (Isaiah 26:3)
 - Stability in turbulent times
 - Emotional equilibrium
- 2. Supernatural Protection (Psalm 91:5-7)
 - Angelic guardianship
 - Divine covering
- 3. Effective Ministry (Acts 4:13)
 - o Boldness in witness
 - Power in service

Generational Impact

- 1. Legacy of Faith (Psalm 112:2)
 - Children blessed
 - Future generations impacted
- 2. **Light to Others** (Matthew 5:14-16)
 - Beacon in dark times
 - Hope dispenser
