TOPIC: THERE IS ALWAYS A WAY

MEMORISE

Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth. Mark 9:23

READ: Luke 8:43-48

- 43 And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any,
- 44 Came behind him, and touched the border of his garment: and immediately her issue of blood stanched.
- 45 And Jesus said, Who touched me? When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said, Master, the multitude throng thee and press thee, and sayest thou, Who touched me? 46 And Jesus said, Somebody hath touched me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of me.

47 And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before him, she declared unto him before all the people for what cause she had touched him, and how she was healed immediately.

48 And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.

RCCG OPEN HEAVEN 25 MAY 2025 TODAY MESSAGE

I don't believe in impossibilities. This is why, when I ask someone to do something, and that fellow says it is impossible, I move on immediately and get someone else to do it.

When we were building Redemption City, some people said it was impossible to build a house within seven days, but we did it. They also said the house would collapse soon, but it has been standing for over 40 years. Then, they said, "It's a bungalow. A storey building will take months to build." However, we built a storey building in 18 days. They moved on to say that it would soon collapse, but it is still standing over 30 years later. In those cases, what we simply did was find a way to double time.

Workers were working on the construction site day and night. That way, what should have taken two days to accomplish only took one. With the help of the Holy Spirit, we were successful – that is what I call divine engineering. No matter how impossible something looks, if you have the Holy Spirit and are determined to get that thing done, there will always be a way.

Several years ago, I was in a faraway country to minister during a Holy Ghost Service. The venue that was used for the service was a rented property, so for me to have a place to stay and pray before the service, they had to bring a motorhome. As I stepped out of the motorhome to go for my ministration, and while the protocol officers were still trying to clear the way for me, a woman who had been barren for many years ran into the motorhome and sat on the seat I had just gotten up from.

The protocol officers ran after her and took her out of the motorhome immediately, but the woman was not bothered because she believed she had gotten her miracle. She had faith that God would give her a miracle child if she could just sit in the motorhome, and she became pregnant that month!

The woman with the issue of blood in today's Bible reading was determined enough to disregard all the obstacles that could have prevented her from touching the hem of Jesus' garment. Sometimes, you will face obstacles in life; however, you must know that with God, nothing is impossible. Trust Him, and don't give up; He will make a way.

Memorise: Mark 9:23 (KJV)

This verse anchors the devotional's core message—faith in God dissolves impossibilities.

Bible Reading: Luke 8:43-48 (KJV)

The account of the woman with the issue of blood demonstrates **determined faith overcoming impossible obstacles** (12 years of incurable sickness, societal restrictions, and physical barriers).

Key Insights from Today's Open Heaven Devotional

1. The Myth of Impossibility

- Biblical Foundation:
 - Divine Perspective: "With God nothing shall be impossible" (Luke 1:37)
 - Human Responsibility: "If thou canst believe..." (Mark 9:23)
- Modern Manifestations:
 - 1. Redemption City Construction: Defied engineering timelines
 - 2. Barren Woman's Miracle: Unconventional faith produced conception

- Joshua's Marching Orders: Unmilitary strategy at Jericho (Joshua 6:3-5)

3. Obstacles to Divine Possibilities

- Four Common Barriers:
 - 1. Human Reasoning: "It can't be done" mentality (Matthew 19:26)
 - 2. Traditional Limitations: "We've never done it that way" (Mark 2:22)
 - 3. Fear of Failure: "What if it doesn't work?" (Hebrews 11:6)
 - 4. Social Opposition: Crowds tried to block the bleeding woman

4. Biblical Models of Impossible Breakthroughs

Situation	Human Perspective	Divine Intervention	Key Lesson
Red Sea (Exodus 14)	Certain death	Path through waters	God makes ways where none exist
Lazarus' death (John 11)	4-days decay	Resurrection power	God's timing transcends natural laws
Feeding 5000 (John 6)	Insufficient food	Supernatural multiplication	Little becomes much in Christ's hands

5. Activating Your Miracle

1. Identify Your "Impossible" Situation

Be specific like the bleeding woman ("If I may touch...")

2. Reject Doubtful Voices

Like the woman ignoring naysayers to touch Jesus' garment

3. Take Faith-Filled Action

- The motorhome woman's bold seating
- Peter stepping on water (Matthew 14:29)

4. Persist Through Obstacles

The Syrophenician woman's persistence (Mark 7:24-30)

Life Applications

For the Discouraged:

- Action: Write down your "impossible" situation circle Mark 9:23 over it
- Prayer: "Holy Spirit, give me divine engineering strategies"

For the Doubting:

- Study: Hebrews 11 faith hall of fame overcoming impossibilities
- Declaration: "My God specializes in things thought impossible!"

For Leaders Facing Challenges:

- Encouragement: The Redemption City model proves:
 - Divine + diligent = Supernatural results
- Warning: Don't let "experts" limit God (1 Corinthians 1:27)

Warning vs. Promise

• Warning: "Unbelief restricts miracles" (Matthew 13:58)

• **Promise:** "All things possible to believers" (Mark 9:23)

Conclusion: Your Impossible is God's Opportunity

- 1. God's resume includes impossible situations your case won't be the exception
- 2. Faith actions attract divine reactions step out like the bleeding woman
- 3. The Holy Spirit provides supernatural strategies seek His engineering
