TOPIC: YOU HAVE A PURPOSE

MEMORISE:

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end
Jeremiah 29:11

READ: Jeremiah 1:4-10

4 Then the word of the Lord came unto me, saying,

5 Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.

6 Then said I, Ah, Lord God! behold, I cannot speak: for I am a child.

7 But the Lord said unto me, Say not, I am a child: for thou shalt go to all that I shall send thee, and whatsoever I command thee thou shalt speak.

8 Be not afraid of their faces: for I am with thee to deliver thee, saith the Lord.

9 Then the Lord put forth his hand, and touched my mouth. And the Lord said unto me, Behold, I have put my words in thy mouth.

10 See, I have this day set thee over the nations and over the kingdoms, to root out, and to pull down, and to destroy, and to throw down, to build, and to plant.

RCCG OPEN HEAVEN 30 SEPTEMBER 2026 TODAY MESSAGE

After Jesus resurrected from the dead, He visited His disciples in John 20:19-22 and said to them. “As my Father hath sent me, even so send I you.”

When God comes into a person’s life, He will give the person a purpose for his or her life. He will share His thoughts and plans with the person and show him or her what the future holds. He will do this because He desires His children to live purposeful lives.

Many people are drifting through life because they haven’t encountered Jesus. They do anything that appeals to them because they have not discovered why God created them. For instance, some of them engage in fraudulent acts just to make money. At the end of the day, they realise that life is more than having money.

Such people become rich but miserable because the wealth they amassed, which they thought would bring them joy and fulfilment, did not. They soon discover that their lives lack meaning despite their wealth. They do not know God’s purpose for their lives, so they continually strive to achieve the next big thing. Unfortunately, after each seemingly big achievement, they tend to sink into despair because they feel as if something is still missing in their lives.

Child of God, no amount of money, fame, or achievement can make a person fulfilled. As long as a person lives outside God’s purpose for his or her life, such a person will not know what true fulfilment is. I have had the opportunity to mingle with the high and mighty, and I have discovered that some people who are poor by societal definitions have more joy and peace than many of them. In today’s memory verse, the Almighty God says that He knows the plans He has towards you, and that they are good.

Beloved, God has a specific plan for your life, and it is only when you align yourself with His plan that you will experience fulfilment. To know His purpose for your life, you must cultivate an intimate relationship with Him because He created you, and no product can fulfil its true purpose outside its manufacturer’s intention and specifications. As you spend quality time with your Maker in prayer and studying His word, your true purpose will become evident. I pray that God will continually guide you along the path of your purpose in Him and supply you with the grace and wisdom to fulfil it, in Jesus name.

OPEN HEAVEN DEVOTIONAL 30 SEPTEMBER 2026

COMMENTARY

The Open Heavens devotional for today, titled **“You Have a Purpose”**, delivers a deeply grounding truth: **you did not appear on this earth by accident**. Grounded in **Jeremiah 1:4-10** and **Jeremiah 29:11**.

It shows us that before you were ever formed in your mother’s womb, God knew you, sanctified you, and set you apart for a specific assignment.

1. The Illusion of Empty Success

It draws our attention to a tragic pattern in our modern world: people drifting aimlessly through life because they have not encountered Jesus and discovered their divine purpose.

When people lack spiritual direction, they tend to do whatever appeals to them to fill the void—including turning to fraudulent or dishonest acts just to make money. Here is the painful reality: wealth amassed outside of God’s will always leaves a person rich but completely miserable. Because they do not know God’s purpose, they chase one worldly milestone after another, only to sink into deep despair after each achievement because that persistent, empty “missing piece” remains.

2. Joy Over Status

Daddy shares a beautiful, eye-opening observation from his own life. Having had the opportunity to mingle with the high and mighty of society, He notes that some people who are considered poor by worldly standards actually possess far more genuine joy and peace than many of the wealthy and powerful.

True fulfillment has absolutely nothing to do with your bank balance, your fame, or your earthly status. It is found solely in aligning your life with the good plans and thoughts that God has established for you.

3. The Manufacturer’s Specifications

To make this spiritual principle easy to understand, Daddy uses the brilliant analogy of a manufacturer and a product. No product can ever fulfil its true purpose outside its manufacturer’s original intention and specifications.

If you buy a smartphone, you cannot use it to hammer a nail into a wall; if you do, you will destroy it because you are violating its design. In the exact same way, when you try to force your life into a shape, career, or relationship that God never designed for you, you will experience frustration and brokenness. The only way to discover your “specs” is to go back to your Creator.

Rise Above Your Limitations

When God called Jeremiah to be a prophet to the nations, Jeremiah immediately shrunk back in fear, crying: *“Ah, Lord God! behold, I cannot speak: for I am a child.”*

How often do we say the same thing to God in our everyday lives? When God prompts you to take a step of faith, start a business, lead a fellowship, or raise your family in holiness, your natural insecurity screams: *“I am not qualified. I am too young. I don’t have the right background.”*

But look at God’s response to Jeremiah: *“Say not, I am a child: for thou shalt go to all that I shall send thee! Be not afraid of their faces: for I am with thee to deliver thee.”* God did not need Jeremiah’s eloquence; He only needed his obedience. God reached out, touched his mouth, put His words in Jeremiah’s lips, and set him over nations to root out, pull down, build, and plant.

To deepen our understanding of this divine calling, let us look at two scriptures not found in the devotional:

- **Ephesians 2:10:** *“For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.”* You are God’s masterpiece. The good works you are meant to accomplish were already prepared before you even arrived.
 - **Colossians 4:17:** *“Take heed to the ministry which you have received in the Lord, that you may fulfill it.”* Fulfilling your purpose requires active attention, focus, and a refusal to be distracted by worldly definitions of success.
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Relating This to Your Everyday Life

It is incredibly easy to get caught up in the rat race of modern life. Society constantly pressures us to believe that our value is tied to our titles, our houses, or the brand of car we drive. You might be working incredibly hard, climbing a career ladder, yet waking up every morning with a heavy sense of emptiness.

Today’s message is a loving invitation to step off the treadmill of human striving. Stop trying to manufacture your own destiny; discover your purpose. Run back to the “Secret Place.” As you spend quality time with your Maker in prayer and in the study of His Word, the blueprint of your life will naturally begin to unfold.

Action Steps

1. **Ditch the World’s Yardstick:** Write down your current goals. Honestly evaluate them and ask: *“Am I chasing this for God’s glory, or simply to prove something to society?”*
2. **Commune with your Maker Daily:** Set aside at least 15 minutes of uninterrupted quiet time every morning to study the Bible and converse with God, asking Him to reveal His specifications for your life. Also keep the thought of God constantly throughout the day.
3. **Reject Ungodly Shortcuts:** If you are currently facing financial pressure, firmly resolve to reject any dishonest, fraudulent, or compromising shortcuts. Trust that God’s good plans will sustain you in His perfect timing.

Prayer Points

1. Father, I thank You with all my heart because You knew me, set me apart, and beautifully ordained my life with a glorious purpose before I was ever formed in my mother's womb, in Jesus's name.
2. Lord Jesus, deliver me from the spirit of aimless drifting; shine Your light upon my path and let me clearly discover why You created me, in Jesus's name.
3. Father, let Your Holy Spirit deliver me from the trap of empty worldly achievements and ungodly wealth; fill my heart with Your supernatural peace and joy, in Jesus's name.
4. Lord, silence every voice of insecurity and fear in my life that says "I am only a child"; clothe me with divine boldness to go wherever You send me, in Jesus's name.
5. Father, put Your words in my mouth and let Your hand touch my life today, empowering me to pull down demonic barriers and build up Your kingdom, in Jesus's name.
6. Lord, grant me the grace and discipline to cultivate a deep, intimate relationship with You daily through prayer and the study of Your Word, in Jesus's name.
7. Father, let Your perfect thoughts of peace and Your expected end for my health, my family, and my career be fully established according to Your perfect will, in Jesus's name

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
