TOPIC: PURPOSE

MEMORISE:

For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, fell on sleep, and was laid unto his fathers, and saw corruption:
Acts 13:36

READ: Isaiah 46:10-11

10 Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:

11 Calling a ravenous bird from the east, the man that executeth my counsel from a far country: yea, I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it.

RCCG OPEN HEAVEN 30 JUNE 2025 TODAY MESSAGE

Before you were born, there was a specific task that God had earmarked for you as an individual. Jeremiah 1:5 made this clear:

Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.

God placed you in the family you were born into for a purpose. He put you where you can fulfil His original purpose for your life. I pray that God will speak to you concerning your purpose and why He has put you in the family you were born into.

Everyone has a specific purpose for which they were born into a family, state, and country. For example, in Exodus 3:1-12, God specifically told Moses, “Your purpose is to bring my people out of Egypt to come and worship me on this mountain.” In Joshua 1:1-8, God told Joshua that it was his assignment to divide the land among His people. In 1 Kings 19:19-21, He let Elisha know, “What you have been doing thus far is farming, and you are doing well, but the work I have for you is to be my prophet.”

When you stop focusing on money and you begin to do what God put you on the earth to do, you will not only get money, but you will also get much more than that. When Elisha took an early retirement from farming and became a prophet, the result was found in 2 Kings 4:12-13. He became so influential that he could say to the Shunammite woman, “Do you want me to talk to the king or the commander-in-chief for you? Whom do you want me to talk to for you?” You must trust God that He will not put you in this world to suffer. Once you have discovered His purpose for your life, start walking in it because that is how you can find fulfilment and all-round joy. He said in Jeremiah 29:11:

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

It is God’s will that you should know His specific purpose for your life and walk in it. If you are yet to know His purpose for your life, go before Him in prayers today and ask Him. He will reveal it to you and give you the grace to

Discovering Your Divine Assignment

This devotional powerfully reminds us that **every believer is created with a specific, preordained purpose**. Before our birth, God meticulously planned our assignment, family background, and sphere of influence to fulfill His eternal plans.

1. The Reality of Divine Preordination

1. Pre-Birth Consecration

- Jeremiah's calling (Jeremiah 1:5)
- Set apart before physical formation

2. Purpose-Driven Placement

- Your family, nation, and era are intentional
- Esther's "for such a time" positioning (Esther 4:14)

3. Customized Assignments

- Moses: Deliverer (Exodus 3:10)
- Joshua: Inheritor (Joshua 1:6)
- Elisha: Prophet (1 Kings 19:16)

The Process of Purpose Fulfillment

1. From Obscurity to Significance

Elisha's transformation demonstrates:

1. Divine Interruption

- Farming to prophesying (1 Kings 19:19-21)
- Ordinary to extraordinary

2. Complete Surrender

- Burned farming equipment (v.21)
- No plan B mentality

3. Exponential Impact

- Access to kings and commanders (2 Kings 4:13)
- Double portion anointing (2 Kings 2:9)

2. The Prosperity of Purpose

1. Beyond Financial Gain

- Purpose first, provision follows (Matthew 6:33)
- Elisha gained influence beyond wealth

2. Divine Connections

- The Shunammite woman's support (2 Kings 4:8-10)
- God sends helpers to purpose-driven lives

3. Ultimate Fulfillment

- Joy in doing God's will (John 4:34)
- David served his generation completely (Acts 13:36)

Practical Steps to Discover and Fulfill Your Purpose

1. Seek Divine Revelation

1. Prayerful Inquiry

- "Lord, why was I born into this family?"
- "What unique assignment do You have for me?"

2. Scriptural Confirmation

- God's thoughts are in His Word (Jeremiah 29:11)
- Study biblical models of calling

3. Prophetic Guidance

- Seek godly counsel (Proverbs 11:14)
- Test all spirits (1 John 4:1)

2. Embrace Your Preparation Process

1. Current Season Matters

- Moses in Midian
- David with sheep

2. Develop Transferable Skills

- Joseph's administrative training in Potiphar's house
- Daniel's education in Babylon

3. Pass the Faithfulness Test

- Small assignments precede greater ones (Luke 16:10)

3. Launch Into Purpose

1. Burn Your Plows

- No retreat options
- Full commitment required

2. Follow Divine Instructions

- Step-by-step obedience
- Like Abraham's "go" (Genesis 12:1)

3. Persist Through Challenges

- Nehemiah's wall-building opposition
- Paul's thorn and perseverance

"Heavenly Father, Architect of my destiny, reveal to me why You formed me and placed me in this generation. Open my eyes to see the specific assignment You've prepared for me. Give me courage
