## OPEN HEAVEN 30 NOVEMBER 2025 TODAY DEVOTIONAL

### TOPIC: SOURCES OF PROPHECY II

#### MEMORISE:

Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

Matthew 7:15

#### READ: Matthew 7:15-21:

15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

16 Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?

17 Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit.

18 A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

19 Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.

20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

## **RCCG OPEN HEAVEN 30 NOVEMBER 2025 TODAY MESSAGE**

Yesterday, I started teaching about the sources of prophecy and how a prophecy can come from the human spirit. Today, I will discuss some ways prophecies can come from the devil.

The prophecies that come from the devil are lies with some elements of truth in them to confuse and derail the recipients. The devil might even misinterpret a portion of the Scriptures to support his lies so that a believer will think that the prophecy is from God.

When a prophecy comes from the devil, it is only a matter of time before it produces the fruits of the devil. When satan gets to a place, he has three assignments: to steal, kill, and destroy (John 10:10). Any prophecy from him will eventually steal from those who believe it, kill their joy and dreams, and destroy their hope.

When the young girl in Acts 16:16-18 said some prophetic words, they had many elements of truth in them. However, Paul knew that her words were from the devil. The devil wanted the people to keep their focus on the girl and not on Jesus. He wanted to distract men from knowing Jesus. The devil knows how to say things and manipulate them to come to pass.

Some people hear prophecies from the devil and just ignore them; however, that can be dangerous. There was a very wealthy man who quarrelled with his wife, and she told him that by the time she was done with him, he would have to walk to get anywhere within Lagos.

When the woman said that, the man laughed because, at that time, he had fourteen cars.

Before long, however, he lost all his cars until he had just one left and only 50 kobo in his pocket. He then said to himself, "If I use this 50 kobo to fuel my car, what will I eat? If I buy food with the money, then I will have to walk around Lagos like my wife prophesied." That was when he came to Jesus Christ, and Jesus began to remedy his situation.

On the day he shared his testimony, he dedicated two new houses. I pray for you today that any negative prophecy that might be working against your life and destiny is nullified, in Jesus' name.

Beloved, you must be careful about the people you give permission to speak into your life. If someone speaks something that is contrary to God's will into your life, plead the blood of Jesus and cancel it immediately.

### **KEY POINT**

If anyone speaks something negative into your life, plead the blood of Jesus and cancel it immediately.

## COMMENTARY

### MEMORISE: Matthew 7:15 (KJV)

*“Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.”*

This command from Jesus is a call to vigilant spiritual discernment. It warns that the source of deception is not always obvious; it often comes disguised in the attire of a believer (‘sheep’s clothing’) but has the destructive nature and intent of a predator (‘ravening wolves’).

### BIBLE READING: Matthew 7:15-21

This passage provides the ultimate test for identifying false prophecy:

- **v. 15-16a:** The initial warning about deceptive appearances, followed by the key to discernment: *“Ye shall know them by their fruits.”*
- **v. 16b-18:** The foundational principle: a good tree (a godly source) cannot bear corrupt fruit (a destructive outcome), and a corrupt tree (a demonic source) cannot bear good fruit. The nature of the source determines the nature of the product.
- **v. 19-21:** The ultimate end of every tree that does not bear good fruit is to be ‘hewn down, and cast into the fire.’ This underscores the eternal seriousness of heeding deceptive words.

## The Wolf’s Guise: Discerning Demonic Prophecy

Pastor E.A. Adeboye continues his vital series by exposing the tactics and fruits of demonically inspired prophecies. He teaches that the enemy’s most effective strategy is not outright falsehood, but a poisonous mixture of truth and lie, designed to deceive, derail, and ultimately destroy the believer’s destiny.

### 1. The Enemy’s Strategy: Truth Tainted with Poison

#### The Bait of Truth:

Demonic prophecies are rarely 100% false. Like the slave girl in Acts 16, they often contain verifiable facts: *“These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation.”* This element of truth is the bait that makes the hook of deception palatable and believable.

#### The Twist of Deception:

The devil’s goal is to use a platform of truth to introduce a destructive agenda. In Acts 16, his aim was to associate the Gospel with a demonic source, creating confusion and distracting from the pure

message of Christ. He often misinterprets Scripture to support his lies, appealing to human reasoning to bypass spiritual discernment.

## 2. The Ultimate Test: Identifying the Devil's Fruit

### The Trinity of Destruction:

Jesus clearly defined the devil's mission: to *steal, kill, and destroy* (John 10:10). Therefore, any prophecy that ultimately produces these outcomes—even if delayed—is from the devil.

- **Steals:** Your peace, your resources, your confidence in God.
- **Kills:** Your joy, your relationships, your God-given dreams.
- **Destroys:** Your hope, your faith, your destiny.

### The Testimony of the Wealthy Man:

The story of the man and his wife is a classic example. The wife's words, spoken in anger, functioned as a demonically-inspired curse. The "fruit" was the systematic loss and destruction of his wealth, exactly as she had spoken, leading him to the brink of despair.

## 3. The Believer's Defense: Proactive Spiritual Warfare

### The Danger of Passive Ignoring:

Daddy Adeboye warns that simply ignoring a negative prophecy can be "dangerous." Spiritual words, even from a wrong source, carry power and must be actively countered with a higher spiritual authority.

### The Power of Immediate Cancellation:

The prescribed defense is swift and decisive: *"Plead the blood of Jesus and cancel it immediately."* The blood of Jesus represents the ultimate victory over all demonic power. To "cancel" a word is to use your authority in Christ to revoke its legal right to operate in your life, rendering it null and void.

## How to Guard Against Demonic Prophecy

### 1. Be Fruit Inspectors, Not Just Word Collectors:

Do not just listen to the content of a prophecy; watch its outcome over time. Does it produce life, peace, and godliness? Or does it produce fear, confusion, and loss? The fruit will always reveal the root.

### 2. Guard Your Spiritual Gate:

*"Be careful about the people you give permission to speak into your life."* Not everyone deserves prophetic access to your destiny. Surround yourself with people known for their integrity, humility, and Christlike character.

### 3. Respond with Authority, Not Fear:

When a negative word is spoken over you, do not receive it into your spirit. Immediately, out loud, declare: *"In the name of Jesus, and by the power of His blood, I cancel and nullify every word spoken against my life and destiny that is not from God. I declare it powerless and of no effect."*

### **Warning: The Deception of Partial Truth**

A prophecy that is 90% true but 10% demonic is 100% dangerous. The enemy knows that pure lies are easy to spot, so he sugar-coats his poison with enough truth to make it believable. This is why we must test every spirit (1 John 4:1).

### **Conclusion: Standing in Your Authority in Christ**

Pray this:

“Lord Jesus, I thank You for Your blood that breaks every chain and cancels every curse. I apply Your blood over my life and destiny right now. I nullify every negative prophecy, every word of death, destruction, and lack that has been spoken over me. I declare that only the plans and purposes of my Heavenly Father for my life will stand. Holy Spirit, sharpen my discernment to instantly recognize and reject every voice that is not Yours, in Jesus’ mighty name.”

### **Action Steps:**

- **Conduct a Word Audit:** Reflect on any negative words spoken over you that you may have passively accepted. Today, actively cancel them in prayer.
- **Study Spiritual Authority:** Read Luke 10:19-20 and Revelation 12:11. Meditate on the authority you have in Christ to tread on serpents and overcome by the blood.
- **Cultivate a Shield of Faith:** Consciously build your faith through the Word of God (Romans 10:17). A strong faith is the shield that can quench all the fiery darts (including fiery words) of the wicked one (Ephesians 6:16).

**Remember:** You are not a victim of words. In Christ, you have been given authority over all the power of the enemy (Luke 10:19). Use that authority to cancel every demonic prophecy and decree the perfect will of God over your life.

*“No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD.” (Isaiah 54:17). This is your heritage—condemn the tongue, do not fear it.*
