## **OPEN HEAVEN 15 MARCH 2025 DEVOTIONAL**

**TOPIC: HE OWNS IT ALL** 

#### **MEMORISE**

God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands;

Acts 17:24

READ: Psalm 24:1-2

The earth is the Lord's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.

2 For he hath founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the floods.

## **RCCG OPEN HEAVEN 15 MARCH 2025 MESSAGE**

Today's Bible reading says that everything on the earth belongs to God, including silver, gold, and the cattle upon a thousand hills. Nobody can be richer than the Owner of the whole earth. Whatever anyone possesses is just a little bit of what God has. The real resources are in His hands, and He can

supply all your needs effortlessly.

In 2 Kings 4:1-7, the widow of one of the sons of the prophets was bankrupt, and creditors wanted to seize her sons as repayment for the debt. However, God intervened, and in a short time, He provided her with so much money that she became debt-free and had enough to live on for her lifetime. In John 6:5-13, He fed 5,000 people with a little boy's lunch.

Afterwards, there were 12 baskets of leftovers. God fed the multitude, and the leftovers were more than what He started with. In Jesus' name, all your needs will be met.

I once travelled to London, and while I was there, I ran out of money. I needed £50 to buy books, and as I went to bed one night, I prayed, "God, I wish I had £50." Soon after, the phone rang. I picked it up, and the caller said,

"Biyi?" I said, "There is no Biyi here." When he asked who I was, I answered, "My name is Adeboye." He asked, "Which Adeboye?" and I said, "Pastor Adeboye of RCCG." He began to scream, and he eventually came over with his brother. When they were leaving, they gave me £50. After they left, I told God that if I knew how easily He could give me £50, I would have asked for £100. Almost ten minutes after saying that, the doorbell rang. However, before I could get to the door, the person left. Underneath the door, I saw an envelope containing another £50 from a rich miser that I had known for a long time. Again, I asked for another £50, and soon after, I miraculously got it. I became afraid and said, "Lord, I am joking. I am already satisfied with the first £50."

God embarrassed me with much more than I needed because He owns everything.

Beloved, there is no limit to what God can do for His children. He is the creator of the entire universe, and He owns it all.

#### **KEY POINT**

God is limitless in what He can do for you when you are His child.

## **OPEN HEAVEN 15 MARCH 2025 COMMENTARY**

## 1. The Foundation: God's Absolute Ownership

The Open Heaven devotional for today begins with a foundational truth: **Everything belongs to God** (Psalm 24:1). This includes:

- Material wealth (silver, gold, cattle on a thousand hills Psalm 50:10).
- Natural resources (Deuteronomy 10:14).
- Human labor (Deuteronomy 8:18).

#### **Key Insight:**

- No one is truly "rich"—we are all stewards of God's resources.
- Scarcity is a lie; God's supply is infinite (Philippians 4:19).

#### **Application:**

- ? Shift your mindset from "I lack" to "My Father owns it all."
- ? Pray with confidence: "Lord, release what I need from Your storehouse!"

#### 2. Biblical Proofs of Divine Provision

Today's devotional highlights two miraculous provisions:

- 1. The Widow's Oil (2 Kings 4:1-7):
  - From debt and despair to abundance and freedom.
  - Principle: God multiplies what we surrender to Him.
- 2. Feeding the 5,000 (John 6:5-13):
  - A boy's lunch? 12 baskets leftover.
  - Principle: God's math: "Little" + obedience = "more than enough."

#### Modern Example (Adeboye's £50 Miracle):

- God used **unexpected sources** (a wrong-number caller, a "miser") to meet the need.
- Lesson: He owns all channels—don't limit how He can provide.

#### 3. The Heart of a Receiver

The devotional reveals 4 postures for accessing God's supply:

- 1. Ask Boldly (Matthew 7:7-8):
  - Adeboye's simple prayer: "I wish I had £50."
- 2. Expect Supernaturally (Ephesians 3:20):
  - He was surprised by excess (£150 instead of £50).
- 3. Steward Faithfully (Luke 16:10-12):
  - The widow **borrowed vessels**; the boy **shared his lunch**.
- 4. Testify Gratefully (Psalm 107:1-2):
  - Share miracles to strengthen others' faith.

#### Warning:

• Fear can limit God's generosity (Adeboye stopped asking after £150).

• Greed distorts trust (Proverbs 30:8-9).

### 4. Overcoming Barriers to Provision

Common obstacles and their solutions:

Barrier	Solution	Scripture
Unbelief	Speak God's promises	Mark 9:23
Disobedience	Repent and align	Malachi 3:8-10
Anxiety	Cast cares on God	1 Peter 5:7
Ingratitude	Thank Him in advance	Philippians 4:6

#### **Prayer Strategy:**

"Father, break every mindset of lack in me. Teach me to receive from Your unlimited riches!"

## 5. Prophetic Declarations for Your Breakthrough

The devotional for today implies God's desire to "embarrass" you with overflow:

- Debt ? Freedom (Like the widow).
- Scarcity ? Abundance (Like the 5,000).
- Need ? Supernatural supply (Like £150).

#### Stand on These Promises:

- "My God shall supply ALL your need..." (Philippians 4:19).
- "The silver and gold are Mine" (Haggai 2:8).

#### **Action Steps:**

- 1. List your needs/wants and present them to God boldly.
- 2. Prepare "vessels" (e.g., save, study, network) for His provision.
- 3. Testify to activate more blessings (Revelation 12:11).

### Final Thought: You Serve the God of "Much More"

Jesus didn't just feed the 5,000 – He left **12 baskets extra**. Why?

- To prove His lordship over scarcity.
- To train the disciples in trust.
- To show that His supply exceeds requests.

"You haven't truly asked until you've asked for the 'leftover baskets'!"

"Owner of all things, I stand on Your Word today. Meet my needs and astonish me with Your generosity, so my life declares: 'The earth is the Lord's!' Amen."

"Your 'need' is God's opportunity to showcase His ownership!"
