And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

John 14:3

READ: Revelation 21:1-11

And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.

² And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

³ And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

⁴ And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

RCCG OPEN HEAVENS 28 JULY 2026 TODAY MESSAGE

Yesterday, I mentioned that some people treat the earth as their home and final resting place. There is, however, another set of people who see heaven as their home and conduct their lives in a way that ensures they will end up there. I am one of such people. In Revelation 21:1, the Bible says that this earth will pass away someday, then verse 2 says: And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

The Scripture above makes us understand that when the earth passes away, people who did not take the earth as their home, those who remained faithful to Jesus Christ, the Husband of the Church, will be in a new Jerusalem that will descend from God out of heaven.

When you read the passage in today's Bible reading further, you will find out that as genuine Christians, we will dwell with God in the same city and be with Him at all times. There will be no more sorrow or weeping for us forever. This is why I do not mind sacrificing anything in this world as long as I make it to heaven. This is because I know that when I get there, it will be joy forevermore.

Indeed, as Romans 8:35-39 says, nothing will ever separate me from the love of my Father, and I am determined to spend eternity with Him. OPEN HEAVENS DEVOTIONAL 28 JULY 2026 COMMENTARY

MEMORISE: John 14:3

"And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also."

This verse is Jesus's personal promise to every believer. Daddy Adeboye anchors today's devotional on this text because it shifts the focus from the temporary earth to the eternal home.

BIBLE READING: Revelation 21:1-11

This passage is John's vision of the new heaven and the new earth.

Two Kinds of People: Earth-Dwellers vs. Heaven-Seekers

"Yesterday, I mentioned that some people treat the earth as their home and final resting place. There is, however, another set of people who see heaven as their home and conduct their lives in a way that ensures they will end up there. I am one of such people."

Earth-Dwellers	Heaven-Seekers
Treat earth as their final home	See earth as a temporary passage
Gather treasures here	Lay up treasures in heaven
Live for the seen, the temporal	Live for the unseen, the eternal
Conduct their lives for earthly comfort	Conduct their lives to ensure they end up in heaven

The First Earth	The New Earth
Passes away	Remains forever
Marred by sin, sorrow, death	No more curse, no more tears
Temporal, decaying	Eternal, imperishable

The New Jerusalem: Our Eternal Home

What Heaven Is	What Heaven Is Not
A real city, the New Jerusalem	A vague, ethereal cloud
Prepared by God Himself	A human invention or wish
Adorned as a bride for her husband	Dull, boring, or empty

Revelation 21:3-4 *â?? â??Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.â?•*

What Will Be Gone in Heaven	What Will Be Present
Death	Eternal life
Sorrow	Everlasting joy
Crying	Rejoicing
Pain	Perfect wholeness
Former things (sin, curse, separation)	God dwelling with His people

Nothing Can Separate Us from God’s Love

“Indeed, as Romans 8:35-39 says, nothing will ever separate me from the love of my Father, and I am determined to spend eternity with Him.”

Romans 8:38-39 *“For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”*

What Cannot Separate Us

Why We Are Secure

Death	Christ conquered the grave
Life	He lives in us
Angels or demons	He is above all powers
Present troubles	He is with us now
Future fears	He has already gone before
Height or depth	His love reaches everywhere

Daddy Adeboye’s Example: Living for Heaven

“When people see me still going on long prayer walks at my age, travelling from place to place to preach the gospel, giving to the poor, and spending and being spent for God, they may not know it or understand it, but I am laying up treasures for myself in heaven because

What Daddy Adeboye Does

Long prayer walks at an advanced age
Travelling to preach the gospel
Giving to the poor
Spending and being spent for God

What He Is Really Doing

Laying up treasures in heaven
Investing in eternal souls
Storing up riches where moth and rust do not corrupt
Building a heavenly portfolio

Revelation 21:23 â?? â??*And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.â?•*

Earthâ??s Light

Sun and moon (created, temporary)
Day and night cycles
Sometimes cloudy, dim
The Lamb is not needed for light

Heavenâ??s Light

The glory of God (uncreated, eternal)
No night, no darkness
Always radiant, always bright
The Lamb is the light

If Daddy Adeboyeâ??a man who has seen glimpses of heavenâ??s beautyâ??is spending his old age praying, preaching, giving, and sacrificing, then heaven must be worth it. If the General Overseer of the Redeemed Christian Church of God, at his age, is still laying up treasures in heaven, you have no excuse to be living for earth.

Do Everything Possible to Make It to Heaven

â??Beloved, do everything possible to ensure that you make it to heaven. I pray that I will see you there, in Jesusâ?? name.â?•

â??Everything Possibleâ?• Includes

Repenting of sin
Believing in Jesus
Living a life of holiness
Serving God sacrificially
Witnessing to the lost
Enduring persecution and hardship

What It Excludes

Continuing in sin
Relying on good works alone
Living a life of compromise
Serving self comfortably
Keeping salvation to yourself
Seeking earthly comfort at all costs

How to Ensure You Make It to Heaven (Practical Steps)

Based on Daddy Adeboye's teaching and Scripture, here is how to live as a heaven-seeker:

1. Settle Your Salvation Today

Do not assume you are going to heaven because you are a good person or because you go to church. Make sure you have genuinely surrendered your life to Jesus Christ. If you are not sure, settle it today.

2. Live with Heaven as Your Goal

Before every decision, ask: *Will this help me get to heaven or hinder me? Will I be glad I did this when I stand before Jesus?* Let heaven be your compass.

3. Lay Up Treasures in Heaven (Matthew 6:19-21)

Earthly Treasure	Heavenly Treasure
Money, possessions, investments	Souls won for Christ
Fame, status, recognition	Faithful service, obedience
Comfort, ease, pleasure	Sacrifices made for the kingdom
Things that rust, decay, or get stolen	Rewards that last forever

4. Do Not Let Earthly Sacrifices Discourage You

You may suffer for your faith. You may be mocked, rejected, or disadvantaged because you choose heaven over earth. But as Daddy Adeboye says, *“I do not mind sacrificing anything in this world as long as I make it to heaven.”*

5. Keep Your Eyes on the Unseen

2 Corinthians 4:17-18 *“For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen.”*

Your Affliction	Your Glory
Light (compared to what is coming)	Far more exceeding
But for a moment (temporary)	Eternal weight of glory

Warning: It Is Possible to Miss Heaven

Daddy Adeboye's devotional carries an urgent warning: not everyone will be in heaven. Only those who remain faithful to Jesus Christ, who do not take the earth as their home, who lay up treasures in heaven—only they will be there.

Who Will Be in Heaven

Who Will Not Be in Heaven

Those who remained faithful to Christ	Those who loved the world more than God
Those who treated earth as temporary	Those who treated earth as their final home
Those who laid up treasures in heaven	Those who stored up only earthly wealth
Those who endured sacrifice for the kingdom	Those who sought comfort at all costs

â??I pray that I will see you there, in Jesusâ?? name.â??•

This is not a casual wish. This is the deepest desire of a spiritual father for his children. Daddy Adeboye wants to see you in heaven. Jesus wants to see you in heaven. The question is: Will you be there?

Conclusion: Your Prayer for Heaven-Bound Living

Daddy Adeboye closes with a prayer that he will see you in heaven. Do not let his prayer be unanswered.

Pray this:

â??Lord Jesus, I thank You that You have gone to prepare a place for me. I thank You that heaven is real, that the New Jerusalem is coming, that there will be no more sorrow or crying or pain. Today, I declare that this earth is not my home. I am only passing through. I will not live for temporal things. I will not chase possessions, status, or comfort at the expense of my eternal soul. I will lay up treasures in heaven. I will pray, preach, give, serve, and sacrificeâ??not to earn my salvation, but because my salvation is already secure, and I want to store up reward. I want to see You face to face. I want to dwell in the city where Godâ??s glory is the light. I want to be with You forever. And I want Daddy Adeboye to see me there. Prepare me. Keep me faithful. And when my time on earth is done, receive me into Your eternal home. In Jesusâ?? mighty name.â??•

Action Steps:

1. **The Eternal Audit:** Look at your life. If you died today, are you 100% certain you would go to heaven? If not, settle it today. Confess your sins. Believe in Jesus. Receive His forgiveness.
2. **The Treasure Check:** Where are you laying up your treasures? On earth (bank accounts, properties, investments) or in heaven (souls, service, sacrifice)? Make one change this week to shift your treasure toward heaven.
3. **The Final Destination Declaration:** Write down: *â??Earth is not my home. Heaven is my destination. I will live today in light of eternity.â??•* Place it where you will see it daily.
