TOPIC: HELP FROM HEAVEN I

MEMORISE:

The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that fear him, and delivereth them.
Psalm 34:7

READ: Psalm 112:1-10

Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments.

2 His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.

3 Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever.

4 Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: he is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.

5 A good man sheweth favour, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion.

6 Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance.

7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD.

8 His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies.

9 He hath dispersed, he hath given to the poor; his righteousness endureth for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honour.

10 The wicked shall see it, and be grieved; he shall gnash with his teeth, and melt away: the desire of the wicked shall perish.

RCCG OPEN HEAVENS 27 OCTOBER 2026 TODAY MESSAGE

A person who fears God will always enjoy assistance from heaven. When I talk about enjoying assistance from heaven, it includes receiving help from beings who live in heaven, specifically the angels.

Today's memory verse tells us that the angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him and delivers them. You can be certain of angelic interventions and rescues when you fear the Lord.

Today's Bible reading refers to someone who fears the Lord as a blessed person. When you fear the Lord and delight greatly in His commandments, you will be blessed, and you can expect angels to intervene in your affairs.

In 1 Kings 19:4-8, when Elijah was so discouraged that he felt like dying, God sent an angel to him twice to strengthen him with food. Before this incident, he had confronted the prophets of Baal, burnt their altars, and killed them. He had purged the land of idolatry because he feared the Lord (1 Kings 18:1-40). In Daniel 6:19-22, an angel came and shut the mouths of lions so that they would not harm Daniel because he chose to obey God's commandments (Daniel 6:4-10). In 2 Kings 19:32-37, a single angel from the Lord fought against Sennacherib and destroyed 185,000 Assyrian soldiers in one night. This was because King Hezekiah was a blessed man who feared the Lord (2 Kings 19:14-19). In Matthew 2:13-15, an angel warned Joseph in a dream that Herod was seeking to kill Jesus. In Acts 12:5-11, an angel came to set Peter free from prison the night before he was to be killed. Every one of these people experienced angelic interventions because they feared God.

A lady once shared her experience during a flight when the aircraft encountered turbulence, and it appeared as if it was going to crash. As she cried out to God for help, she looked out of the window and saw an angel smiling at her as he carried the plane in the palm of his hand. Immediately, she stopped being anxious and became assured that there was nothing to worry about. I prophesy to you that God will send His angel to rescue you in turbulent times, in Jesus's name.

Beloved, when you fear the Lord and obey His commandments at all times, you can rest assured that the hosts of angels in heaven will come to your aid in times of need.

PRAYER POINT

Father, please help me to fear You and obey Your commandments so that I will enjoy help from heaven, in Jesus's name.

OPEN HEAVEN DEVOTIONAL 27 OCTOBER 2026 COMMENTARY

Today's devotional, **Help from Heaven I**, opens our eyes to a wonderful truth: when you fear the Lord, you enjoy assistance from heaven including help from angels.

A person who fears God will always enjoy divine assistance. Psalm 34:7 promises that the angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him and delivers them. Psalm 112 describes such a person as blessed their seed is mighty, wealth and riches are in their house, light arises in darkness, and they are not afraid of evil tidings.

When you fear the Lord and delight in His commandments, you can expect angels to intervene in your affairs.

1. Angelic Help Is Promised to Those Who Fear God

You can be certain of angelic interventions and rescues when you fear the Lord. Today's Bible reading calls the person who fears the Lord blessed. When you fear Him and delight in His commandments, you will be blessed and angels will intervene in your affairs.

Angels sent by God to minister to those who will inherit salvation (Hebrews 1:14).

2. Biblical Examples of Angelic Intervention

Daddy gives us powerful examples:

- **Elijah** (1 Kings 19:4-8) When he was so discouraged he wanted to die, God sent an angel twice to strengthen him with food.
- **Daniel** (Daniel 6:19-22) An angel shut the mouths of lions because Daniel obeyed God's commandments.
- **King Hezekiah** (2 Kings 19:32-37) A single angel destroyed 185,000 Assyrian soldiers in one night because Hezekiah feared the Lord.
- **Joseph** (Matthew 2:13-15) An angel warned him in a dream that Herod was seeking to kill Jesus.
- **Peter** (Acts 12:5-11) An angel set him free from prison the night before he was to be killed.

Every one of these people experienced angelic intervention because they feared God.

3. A Modern Testimony of Angelic Protection

Daddy shares a testimony of a lady on a flight. The aircraft encountered turbulence, and it appeared it was going to crash. As she cried out to God for help, she looked out the window and saw an angel smiling at her â?? carrying the plane in the palm of his hand. Immediately, she stopped being anxious and became assured that there was nothing to worry about.

You may not always see the angel, but the angel sees you. You may not know how God is protecting you, but He is. The same angel that carried that plane is assigned to carry you.

Relating This to Your Everyday Life

You may be facing a turbulent situation right now â?? in your health, your finances, your family, or your future. It may feel like your plane is about to crash. But todayâ??s message reminds you: when you fear the Lord, heaven is on your side.

You may not see the angel. You may not feel the protection. But God has given His angels charge over you. They encamp around you. They deliver you. They carry you in their hands.

So fear the Lord. Obey His commandments. Delight in His Word. And rest assured: the hosts of heaven are working on your behalf.

Action Steps

1. Fear the Lord and Obey His Commandments â?? Angelic help is promised to those who fear God. Make it your priority to honor Him in every area of your life.

2. Pray for Angelic Intervention â?? When you face battles you cannot fight, ask God to send His angels on your behalf. He has promised to do it.

3. Trust God in Turbulent Times â?? When things seem out of control, remember that God is still in control. The angel is carrying the plane. You can rest.

Prayer Points

1. Father, I thank You for the promise of angelic help. Thank You for the angels You have assigned to encamp around me and deliver me, in Jesusâ?? name.
2. Lord, forgive me for the times I have forgotten that I am not alone. Forgive me for living in fear when heaven is on my side, in Jesusâ?? name.
3. Father, I choose to fear You and delight in Your commandments. Let my life be pleasing to You, so that I may enjoy the fullness of Your protection, in Jesusâ?? name.
4. Lord, send Your angels to fight my battles. Every enemy, every attack, every plan of darkness â?? let Your angels scatter them, in Jesusâ?? name.

5. Father, I decree that no weapon formed against me shall prosper. I am shielded by angelic hosts because I fear the Lord, in Jesusâ?? name.
6. Lord, in turbulent times, let me see Your hand. Open my eyes to see the chariots of fire around me. Let me not be afraid, in Jesusâ?? name.
7. Father, I declare that I will not be moved. My heart is fixed, trusting in You. I will see my desire upon my enemies, in Jesusâ?? name.

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
